The Great Aussie Rickshaw Ride
Kibble Park, Gosford
11 August , Kibble Park Gosford

The Great Aussie Rickshaw Ride is coming to Gosford on their journey between Eumundi QLD and Evandale TAS on 11 August 2010. More than 400 volunteers will ride in relay format, visiting schools, churches and community groups along the route. This event has been made possible by a grant from AusAid in order to not only raise awareness about global poverty but promote the millennium development goals to eradicate poverty. In particular, this event is featuring the work in Bangladesh of an organisation called Symbiosis.

The ride commences on 14 July in Eumundi QLD and finishes on 19 Sept, in Tasmania. The Rickshaw and support crew will arrive in Kibble Park, Gosford on Wednesday 11 August 2010 at 4pm and be

welcomed by the Mayor of Gosford, Councillor Chris Holstein.
